The International Association of Fire Fighters has purchased and has been coordinating with the Kelsey-Seybold Clinic to provide free Hepatitis A and Tetanus vaccinations for members who have been exposed to the floodwaters resulting from Hurricane Harvey.

According to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), persons that have entered floodwaters should receive Hepatitis A vaccinations within 2 weeks of their initial exposure. For those members that have previously been inoculated against Hepatitis A, this injection will serve as a post-exposure booster shot. For those that have never been inoculated against Hepatitis A, it will be necessary to receive a second dose 6 months from your first injection. If you require the second dose in the series, you will need to contact your health care provider to schedule. There may be some cost if your department is not providing.

Beginning Wednesday, Sept 6, free Hepatitis A and Tetanus vaccines will be offered to IAFF members at two Kelsey-Seybold locations, one in The Woodlands/ Conroe area and the other in the La Marque, Texas City and Galveston area.

The locations of the Kelsey-Seybold Clinics are as follows:

- The Woodlands Clinic at 106 Vision Park Drive, Shenandoah, Texas 77384, and
- The Clear Lake Clinic at 1010 S. Ponds, Drive, Webster, Texas 77594.

Clinic hours for the above locations are as follows:

- Monday through Friday 8 a - 5 p both locations, and
- Clear Lake is also open Saturday 9 a - 2p.

Members can pre-schedule a time for immunization by calling (713)442-0000, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. IAFF members that are current Kelsey-Seybold patients can also schedule an appointment online using their www.MyKelseyOnline.com account.

IAFF members can also "walk in" to either location without pre-scheduling. However, keep in mind if you walk in, know that Kelsey-Seybold will do its best to minimize any wait times for you, but there could be a wait.

IAFF members in the City of Houston can also go to Local 341 Union Hall to receive vaccinations until Friday September 8th, 2017 from 08:00 AM to 3:00 PM.
