



Burlington in Oakledge Park

It parallels the lake shore before reaching Burlington's downtown waterfront.

To the north, the trail runs past beaches and through nature reserves, over the graceful arc

of the Winooski River bridge, to the shores of Mallett's Bay and the spectacular 3 1/2 mile long Colchester Causeway

This historic marble causeway connects the Lake Champlain Islands with Greater Burlington, offering unparalleled views of the Green Mountains and the Adirondacks. Hikers and bikers can literally reach the middle of Lake Champlain without the need for a boat
