




The Narrabri coal seam gas project plans to drill right through a recharge zone of the Great Artesian Basin, putting at risk groundwater needed by farmers to grow food and fibre.



The Bylong coal mine east of Mudgee puts at risk beautiful heritage properties with a rich horse-breeding history in the magnificent Bylong valley which has never been targeted for coal mining before.



The Hume coal mine in the Southern Highlands will pollute local waterways, cause water to drop in at least 93 farm bores and undermine a vital part of Sydney's drinking water catchment.
