### **III. Membership**

**Section 1.** General Membership: Any **resident of Nevada** shall be considered a member of the LPN **provided they are a registered Libertarian Party partisan voter in Nevada.**

**Section 2.** Dues-paying Membership: Any resident of Nevada shall be considered a dues-paying member of the LPN provided they:

A. **Are a member of the LPN, and**

B. **Have donated at least sixty dollars (\$60) in monetary or in-kind contributions to the LPN in the past 365 days.**

### **III. Membership**

**Section 1.** General Membership: Any **person registered to vote as LPN** shall be considered a member of the LPN.

**Section 2.** Dues-paying Membership: Any resident of Nevada shall be considered a dues-paying member of the LPN provided they:

A. **Already qualify as a general member under Section 1,**

B. **and have donated at least sixty dollars (\$60) in monetary or in-kind contributions to the LPN in the past 365 days.**

### **Author's Note in Favor:**

For section 1, person registered to vote is all that's needed here since you must be a resident of the state of Nevada to be registered as LPN. It also removes the ambiguity of whether national Party membership AND state residency are sufficient – we want them to be registered LPN and don't care about the rest.





For section 2, Removes the ambiguity of “are a member of the LPN” – could be interpreted as a recursive definition. Better to just refer to section 1; that way, whatever it says there establishes the general membership requirements.
