Delete Last Sentence of 2.5 Money and Financial Markets	SUPPORT
General Cleanup of 1.6 Crime and Justice	OPPOSE * - The State sucks.
New 1.7 Death Penalty plank	SUPPORT * - The LPRC favours the expected Minority Report version, but support this language if that effort does not pass.
Delete 4.0 Omissions	OPPOSE * - No, no, no, f**k no.
Delete 2.3 Energy and Resources	OPPOSE
New 2.3 Energy and Resources Plank	NO POSITION
Split Plank 2.4 into Multiple Planks	OPPOSE * - The LPRC opposes the Platform Committee recommendations in the strongest possible terms and conversely strongly supports the expected Minority Report recommendations.
