



Support SB 280 Minimum Wage Without Amendments

'CLEAN \$15' MINIMUM WAGE BILL

The House Economic Matters Committee voted out the 'fight for \$15' bill to increase minimum wages (HB166) with amendments that significantly weaken the bill and leave too many workers behind. The amendments extended the phase-in by two years, stripped out a measure to keep minimum wages rising with the cost of living, denied the increase to agricultural workers and continued to freeze tipped worker salary at \$3.63.

The Senate bill SB280 was heard in the Senate Finance Committee. If your Senator is on that committee, contact your Senator and tell them you want the bill approved without amendments.
