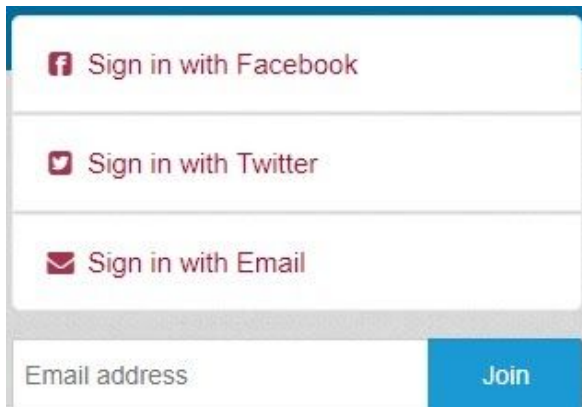


Thanks to Ashley's research we have learned that visitors to many of our our websites who have never logged in see the lower item in this image in the side navigation panel:



I confess, since I am always logged in, I had never seen that little "Join" box right below "Sign in with Email", or maybe I just ignored it!

So it turns out that despite the clear label (Join), when an email address is entered and the button is clicked, the user does not get directed to your join page.

However the person who originally set up your first NB pages DOES get a mysterious email that indicates that "Username" has just volunteered!

In addition to the three sign in options we do provide users should be able to quickly find our official join pages, so my recommendation is that you remove the code that generates this additional box.

Here are the steps:

1. From your Control Panel
2. Select your website
3. Select Theme
4. Select Files
5. Scroll down to the file named "_signup_form.html"
6. In place of the 26 lines of code, instead paste in the abbreviated lines below:

(Do remember to click on "Save and publish"!

That is all it takes. This will remove this NB signup box option from all of your pages that display a side menu panel.
