
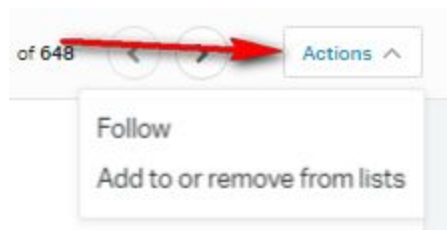



Voting districts

NB matches the voting districts for us if a physical address is entered. At this writing we had 648 profiles in CD7, for example.


To do your own search, use the funnel icon  on the People page, add a criteria, start typing federal and Federal District pops up as your matching choice. Enter a 7 in the open box,

click the blue  button and Voila!



Now add them to a list by clicking  as indicated and choose the Add to or remove from lists option. You'll need this list when you get over to the Communicator and want to choose recipients.

To see all of the voting district options, on the People tab, select someone, chose Location in their menu and then Voting districts. Here's an example

and all of the options will be displayed. I chose someone with some tags, figuring this profile was more likely to include an address (though it did not in this case).

NB only populates federal, state upper (senate) and state lower (house). Local Leagues can choose to manually populate the finer sub-districts.
