



My Voting Plan

Step 1 – Register or Check Registration Accuracy

- Register to vote using one of the sites below <https://voterservices.elections.maryland.gov/OnlineVoterRegistration/InstructionsStep1> or <https://www.vote.org/register-to-vote/> or www.vote411.org
- If already registered, check to ensure your voter registration record is correct <https://voterservices.elections.maryland.gov/VoterSearch>
- Complete, sign and return mail-in ballot application in postage-paid envelope if you intend to vote by mail
- If you did not receive an application for a mail-in ballot by September 8, call Calvert BOE at 410-535-2214

Step 2 – If you plan to vote-by-mail:

- Complete your mail-in ballot immediately upon receipt
- Follow the instructions carefully—vote for the right number of candidates
- **Sign the oath or your vote will NOT count**
- **NEVER GIVE YOUR BALLOT TO ANYONE! MAIL OR DROP IT OFF PERSONALLY!**
- Return your mail-in ballot:
 - Mail your mail-in ballot in the postage-paid envelope provided **OR**
 - Drop your mail-in ballot at one of the seven (7) secure drop boxes in Calvert County
 - Calvert Board of Elections, Prince Frederick
 - Southern Community Center, Lusby
 - Northeast Community Center, Chesapeake Beach
 - Calvert High School, Prince Frederick
 - Huntingtown High School, Huntingtown
 - Northern High School, Owings
 - Patuxent High School, Lusby **OR**
 - Drop off at one of the five vote centers
 - Calvert Board of Elections, Prince Frederick
 - Calvert High School, Prince Frederick
 - Huntingtown High School, Huntingtown
 - Northern High School, Owings
 - Patuxent High School, Lusby **OR**
 - Drop off at Calvert BOE during Early Voting

Step 3 – Vote In-Person

- Do not vote in-person if you have already submitted a mail-in ballot. If you have checked the status of your mail-in ballot and are concerned it will not be counted, only then should you attempt in-person voting. You will be given a provisional ballot, which will only count if your mail-in ballot has not been counted. **It is a felony to vote twice.**
- Calvert voters may vote during the early voting period, Monday, October 26 through Monday, November 2 from 7 am to 8 pm **ONLY at the Calvert BOE.**
- Calvert voters may vote at **ANY** of the following vote centers on Election Day, Tuesday, November 3, between 7 am and 8 pm
 - Calvert BOE, Prince Frederick
 - Calvert High School, Prince Frederick
 - Huntingtown High School, Huntingtown
 - Northern High School, Owings
 - Patuxent High School, Lusby
