

Bureau Report on changes to Jeunes Radicaux de Gauche

In accordance with LYMEC's Statutes, the membership of a member organisation that merges with a non-member organisation must be confirmed by Congress:

Article 16 - Changes in member organisations

(1) If a full member or associate member organisation merges with a non-member organisation, its membership in LYMEC must be confirmed by an absolute majority of those present and voting at the next Autumn Congress.

The new member organisation must comply with the criteria as set out in Article 10 of these Statues, except for the third point in Article 10 (3). All the necessary requirements must be transmitted in writing to the Bureau at least eight weeks prior to the Congress.

Jeunes Radicaux de Gauche, LYMEC associate members since 2013, have merged with the organisation Jeunes Radicaux Valoisiens and formed the new organisation Jeunes Radicaux in June 2018. The LYMEC Secretary General was present at the official merger of the two organisations.

The new, merged organisation would like to take over the membership of Jeunes Radicaux de Gauche. We have examined the application and our assessment is that the new organisation fulfils the criteria in article 10 of the LYMEC Statutes. It should also be mentioned that Jeunes Radicaux Valoisiens were part of UDI Jeunes, LYMEC associate members since 2017.
