

## Bureau Report on how Young Progressives fulfil the criteria set out in the LYMEC Statutes article 11 (2) and (3)

As becomes evident in the Application Form, the Young Progressives is a national youth organisation run by and for young people, based in a European country (Slovakia). They express in their application that they agree with the LYMEC Statutes and Manifesto, and that they are not members of any other Pan-European political organisation that is not based on liberal, radical democratic ideas. The Young Progressives has provided the LYMEC Secretariat with a copy of both its Statutes and its Manifesto, both in English and in Slovak, and has declared how membership is defined as well as the approximate number of members (100), they have declared their links to other organisations and provided information on their sources of finance.

Representatives from the Young Progressives attended the ALDE Summer Academy, where we had the opportunity to meet and discuss their possible LYMEC membership further.
