

Bureau Report on how Jeunes Radicaux fulfil the criteria set out in the LYMEC Statutes article 10 (2) and (3)

As becomes evident in the Application Form, Jeunes Radicaux is a democratically organised national youth organisation run by and for young people, based in a European country (France). They express in their application that they agree with the LYMEC Statutes and Manifesto, and that they are not members of any other Pan-European political organisation that is not based on liberal, radical democratic ideas. Jeunes Radicaux has provided the LYMEC Secretariat with a copy of both its Statutes and its Manifesto, both in English and in French, and has declared how membership is defined as well as the approximate number of members (300), they have declared their links to other organisations and provided information on their sources of finance. The predecessor of Jeunes Radicaux (Jeunes Radicaux de Gauche) were members of LYMEC since 2013.

Furthermore, the Vice President of Jeunes Radicaux will attend the Young Leaders Meeting 2018.
