

## Bureau Report on how LDLU fulfil the criteria set out in the LYMEC Statutes article 10 (2) and (3)

As becomes evident in the Application Form, LDLU is a democratically organised national youth organisation run by and for young people, based in a European country (Ukraine). They express in their application that they agree with the LYMEC Statutes and Manifesto, and that they are not members of any other Pan-European political organisation that is not based on liberal, radical democratic ideas. LDLU has provided the LYMEC Secretariat with a copy of both its Statutes and its Manifesto, both in English and in Ukrainian, and has declared how membership is defined as well as the number of members (135), they have declared their links to other organisations and provided information on their sources of finance. LDLU has been an associate member of LYMEC since 2017.
