Register To Vote by October 13

Make sure you're registered to vote at [KSVotes.org](https://ksvotes.org)!



Vote By Mail (it's safe and easy!)

- A lot of counties sent mail-in ballot applications this year. If you turned it back in, **your ballot will be sent some time after Oct. 14**
- Check your application status (available in Oct.) at myvoteinfo.voteks.org
- Still need to request a mail-in ballot? Request it online at [KSVotes.org](https://ksvotes.org)

Worried about your ballot getting in on time?!



- Drop your ballot at **any early voting location**
- Drop your ballot at any designated "dropbox"
- Drop your ballot at your **County Clerk or Election Office**
- Drop it at **your polling place** on Election Day
