Voting Instructions:

- This ballot utilizes **Instant Run-off Voting**, a method supported by Green Party organizations across the nation.
- For each race, mark you FIRST preference with a #1, your 2nd preference with a #2, and so on. You may rank as many preferences as you like.
- ONLY vote in the Congressional district in which you are registered to vote. We will not count any vote made in a district where you do not reside, according to the information provided on the opposite side of this ballot.
- If no candidate wins a majority of votes on the first round of voting, we move into an “instant run-off” by eliminating the lowest choice, and counting the 2nd choice of those ballots. This method ensures that a candidate wins a majority of votes and reflects the preference of the voters most accurately.
- If **None of the Above** wins, all of the above candidates are eliminated but the party may seek and nominate a different candidate at a later date.
- If **No Nominee** wins, there shall be no Green Party Nominee in that race.

Example: 2 Minnie Mouse
 1 Donald Duck
 3 None of the Above
 _____ No Nominee

(The voter above wants Donald Duck as her first choice. If Donald gets eliminated after the first round, she chooses Minnie Mouse. If Minnie gets eliminated after round 2, she chooses None of the Above).
