Rationale:

This form was created in accordance with Green Party values. We value Grassroots Democracy, which includes key electoral reforms. In general, we want to include as many voters as possible in the electoral process and increase voter participation.

The Maryland Green Party has long supported the efforts of voting rights coalitions, which have sought to enfranchise people with former felony convictions. We are happy to note that these coalitions have been successful at changing the laws of Maryland, and as of March 10, 2016, voting rights shall be restored to all individuals once they are released from prison, regardless of probation status.

The Maryland Green Party believes, furthermore, that many high school students are very informed about the issues, and the voting age should be lowered to 16. This will increase youth participation in politics, which would be very valuable to our democracy.

Finally, Maryland Greens support immigration reform that would bring many people "out of the shadow," and give full legal status to immigrants who have made Maryland their home. We do not want to wait around for Congress to act on this important issue. In the meantime, we welcome ALL Maryland residents, regardless of citizenship status, to participate in our internal decision-making.
