

It has come to our attention that many of our constituents are concerned about whether they will be allowed to vote if they are not vaccinated or exempt from wearing a mask. Despite some posts circulating social media stating otherwise, we would like to remind everyone that they will still be allowed to vote regardless of the passport system.

Voters can bring this printable reference sheet to bring to polling stations as it has come to our attention that a number of returning officers and station supervisors are not following the policies clearly laid out by Elections Canada. Constituents should feel ***comfortable and confident*** in the system when going to vote, the following QR code can be provided in any instance where there is a dispute at a polling station.

Municipal guidelines and rules set out by landlords of individual polling station sites ***DO NOT*** supersede voters constitutional right to vote.
