Counts are weather dependent. Please check with us before coming out on count day.

These counts are conducted for the North American Butterfly Association under a research permit from Joshua Tree National Park. Volunteers are needed to observe and record butterflies for a one-day period within a 15-mile diameter circle. Counts are held each year during seasons of peak butterfly diversity. Each census will add to our knowledge of the geographical distribution and population size of the species counted. No experience necessary.
