Workshop Topic: The purpose of the Planning Commission Workshop is to provide information regarding an ordinance proposed to replace the current Development Code Chapter 83.70 "Glare and Outdoor Lighting" with a new Chapter 83.70 "Light Trespass". The workshop will give the Planning Commission and the public an opportunity to provide feedback to staff for potential refinement of the proposed ordinance before it is presented to the Planning Commission in a public hearing to be scheduled at a later date.

The County of San Bernardino is continuing to hold Planning Commission meetings to conduct essential County business. Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order, members of the Planning Commission may attend the meeting via teleconference or video conference and will participate in the meeting to the same extent as if they were present. As the County begins to reopen for in-person services, the Planning Commission meetings will also reopen to the public. Members of the public may continue to participate in the meeting remotely. Public access to the Government Center will be through the west doors, facing Arrowhead Avenue. All members of the public entering the building are required to go through a security scan. Those wishing to attend the board meeting will be sent directly to the chambers.

- (4) If attending the meeting in person, please note that facial coverings will be required and seating in the board chambers will be limited to ensure appropriate social distancing is maintained.

If you challenge any decision regarding the above proposal in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing.

NOTE: The Planning Commission in its deliberation could approve an alternative proposal for the above Project.
