Joseph Selvaggi 8th Congressional District

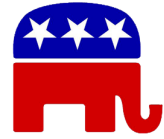
Christopher Sheldon 9th Congressional District

Both Selvaggi and Sheldon answered the National Right to Life Committee questionnaire pro-life.

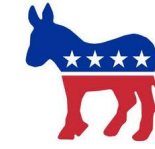
