**Mary's Home in Maryland** | 3675 Park Ave., Ellicott City  
Two group homes provide a safe environment for expectant mothers and their children who are in crisis

## COMMUNITY RESOURCES

**Faith Journeys Foundation** | Ellicott City  
Pastoral program to help children of divorce

**Little Portion Farm** | 12280 Folly Quarter Rd, Ellicott City  
Sustainable farming by the Franciscan friars and volunteers that protects the land while providing fresh produce that is donated to a Baltimore food kitchen to make healthy meals for those in need

**St. Vincent de Paul Society**  
Provides a range of support for local residents suffering from the effects of poverty: child and family services, permanent supportive housing, workforce development, healthy meals for food-insecure children (more than 104,000 meals served in Baltimore County last year)

- **Parish-based Outreach in District 9**  
Resurrection, St. Paul, and St. Joseph parishes provide food, utility and rent assistance, and other support to help people through difficult times

Behavioral health services, including counseling, psychiatric evaluation, social and coping skill development, and medication management

3774 Plum Meadows Dr., Ellicott City  
Volunteer organization promoting justice, equality, the advancement of human rights, and human dignity for all

**Shrine of St. Anthony** | 12290 Folly Quarter Rd., Ellicott City  
A ministry of the Franciscan Friars Conventual, this 310-acre property provides opportunities for prayer and contemplation, as well as meetings. A solar field and sustainable farming reflect a commitment to care for creation.

**Carrollton Hall** | 12290 Folly Quarter Rd., Ellicott City  
This 1832 home, a gift from Charles Carroll, signer of the Declaration of Independence, to his granddaughter, is part of Maryland's history, and recently has been restored. The original "folly" is part of the Shrine of St. Anthony property and includes exhibit and event space.

**Retreat and Conference Center at Bon Secours**  
1525 Marriottsville Rd., Marriottsville  
This 300-acre property draws visitors for meetings and spiritual retreats; a ministry of the Sisters of Bon Secours, the property includes a number of meeting spaces and 70 overnight guest rooms

**Sisters of Bon Secours USA and Bon Secours Health System**  
1525 Marriottsville Rd., Marriottsville  
Bon Secours Health System provides hospitals, clinics, home health care, assisted living and more in six states. The sisters opened Baltimore's first daycare facility in 1907 to help working mothers be able to keep their children, the first Catholic center for those with physical challenges in 1916, and their first hospital in Baltimore in 1919.
