- **Parish Partners Program**
Program connects Catholic parishes seeking to assist local families in the community with Catholic Charities' expertise and services; provides training, networking and support for the development of parish social ministries; and publishes a county-based emergency service guide
- **Immigration Legal Services**
Pro bono assistance
- **Legal Network**
Pro bono legal services regarding debt, employment, family law, landlord-tenant, public benefits, wills/probate, guardianship and conservatorship
- **Community Companions**
After-school programs, in-home support, respite breaks and camps in special needs families when caregivers need to work or rest
- **Community Options**
Day program for adults with severe cognitive or physical disabilities
- **Financial Stability Network**
Pro bono financial services, including financial coaching, education, and tax assistance for low income families to increase income, build and sustain assets

- **Sanctuaries for Life**

Support for women facing an unintended pregnancy, including prenatal care, labor/delivery, and connections for housing, food, clothing, and education

- **SHARE Food Network**

Discount grocery program that is community-based and open to all, possible through high-volume purchasing and volunteer engagement

- **Strong Families Initiative**

Provides youth an outlet to discuss hardships they are facing, to be better equipped to face future difficulties

- **Welcome Home Reentry Program**

Volunteer mentoring to men and women returning to their communities after incarceration
