Transitional shelter providing case management, substance abuse counseling, education, employment services and referrals for adults experiencing homelessness and struggling with addiction or mental health issues

- **Holistic services from Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Washington** including case management; crisis intervention; referrals, food pantry, mobile market (produce distribution); clothing, shoes and diapers; parent education and empowerment; financial education, coaching and tax assistance for low-income families; rent, mortgage and utility assistance; pro bono immigration legal services; and care for pregnant women
- **Neighborhood Service Center**, a partnership with Montgomery County DHS and IMPACT Silver Spring, that provides residents the opportunity to apply for benefits and financial assistance programs

Additional Catholic Charities programs available to residents in District 18 include:

- **Legal Network** - Pro bono legal services including issues with debt, employment, family law, landlord-tenant, public benefits, wills and probate, guardianship and conservatorship
- **Sanctuaries for Life** - Support program for women facing an unintended pregnancy, including prenatal care, labor/delivery, and connections for housing, food, clothing, and education.
- **Spanish Catholic Center** - Holistic services to immigrants, including medical and dental care, job training, English classes, and case management
- **Supported Employment Program** - Support for adults with developmental disabilities to enter the workforce
- **SHARE Food Network**
Discount grocery program that is community-based and open to all, possible through high-volume purchasing and volunteer engagement

Volunteer mentoring for men and women returning to their communities after incarceration to help them find a job, home and support
