HOUSING AND SERVICES FOR THE HOMELESS

Christopher Place Employment Academy
Intensive residential program providing education, training, and recovery support to formerly homeless men of the Baltimore area

Earn Benefits
Screening program for public benefits and financial assistance

Project Promise, Project Reach
Permanent individual housing for homeless people with disabilities

Project FRESH Start
Helps eligible homeless families find stable, affordable housing

COMMUNITY RESOURCES

St. Vincent de Paul Society
Catholic non-profit that provides support for local residents suffering from the effects of poverty: child and family services, permanent supportive housing, workforce development, healthy meals for food-insecure children (more than 104,000 meals served in Baltimore County last year)

New All Saints and St. Cecilia-Immaculate Conception parishes sponsor youth for summer camp, prepare lunch packages for homeless shelters, and distribute clothing, toiletries and food baskets to those in need

Family Provider Partnership | Catholic Charities
Engages families in sharing responsibility for how services are provided; includes family support groups throughout central Maryland

SHARE Food Network | Catholic Charities
A community-based organization open to all, offering groceries at a discount, through high-volume purchasing and volunteer support

HEALTH CARE AND RELATED SERVICES

Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Baltimore
offers a wide range of health care services for residents of the Baltimore region, including

- **Baltimore Child and Adolescent Response System**
Comprehensive community-based services for children in mental health crisis
- **Home-Based Respite Program**
Professional staff provide therapeutic opportunities for children with mental health challenges, while also giving a break to the caregiver

- **In-Home Intervention Programs**
Intensive in-home intervention to empower families, divert children from hospitalization or residential treatment, and maintain children in their homes
- **Mental Health Assessment Team**
Mental health assessments for children entering the child welfare system in Baltimore City
- **Villa Maria Behavioral Health Clinic at Fallstaff**
