Safe Start

Assessment and intervention program for families focusing on preventing child abuse and neglect by providing services such as behavioral management techniques, stress management, problem-solving, budgeting, communication and organization skills

HEALTH CARE AND RELATED SERVICES | CATHOLIC CHARITIES

Villa Maria Behavioral Health Clinic

Behavioral health services, including counseling, psychiatric evaluation, social and coping skill development, and medication management.

Family and Kinship Navigator Services

A resource and referral program for children with needs related to mental health or developmental disabilities

Family-to-Family Respite Program

Overnight relief for caregivers who face the challenge of raising a child with emotional or behavioral problems

Home-Based Respite Program

A professional provides therapeutic opportunities for children with mental health challenges, while giving a break to the caregiver.

In-Home Intervention Programs

Provides intensive in-home intervention to empower families, divert children from hospitalization or residential treatment and maintain children in their homes.
