HOUSING AND SERVICES FOR THE HOMELESS CATHOLIC CHARITIES

Dorothy Day Place

Transitional shelter providing case management, substance abuse counseling, education, employment services, and referrals for adults experiencing homelessness and struggling with addiction or mental health issues is available to District 39

COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Catholic Charities Parish Partners program links local needs with programs and services, such as:

- **Catholic Charities Center**
Case management; crisis intervention; food; clothing; parental and financial education; rent, mortgage and utility assistance; immigration legal services; and services for pregnant women
- **Immigration Legal Services**
Pro bono legal immigration services for foreign-born individuals and their families
- **Legal Network**
Pro bono legal services including issues with debt, employment, family law, landlord-tenant, public benefits, wills and probate, guardianship and conservatorship
- **Community Companions**
After-school programs, in-home support, respite breaks and camps in special needs families when caregivers need to work or rest
- **Financial Stability Network**
Pro bono financial services, including financial coaching, education, and tax assistance for low income families to increase income, build and sustain assets
- **Sanctuaries for Life**
Support program for women facing an unintended pregnancy, including prenatal care, labor/delivery, and connections for housing, food, clothing, and education.
- **Spanish Catholic Center**
Holistic services to immigrants from around the world, including medical and dental care, job training, English classes, food pantry, and case management
- **Supported Employment Program**
Support for adults with developmental disabilities to enter the workforce

- **SHARE Food Network**
Discount grocery program that is community-based and open to all, possible through high-volume purchasing and volunteer engagement
- **Strong Families Initiative**
Provides youth an outlet to discuss hardships they are facing, to be better equipped to face future difficulties
- **Welcome Home Reentry Program**
Volunteer mentoring to men and women returning to their communities after incarceration

HEALTH CARE AND RELATED SERVICES

Catholic Charities programs available to residents include:

- **Health Care Network**
Connects low-income and uninsured patients with specialized, pro bono health care services
- **Catholic Charities Medical Clinics**
Affordable primary care for uninsured or under-insured low-income families
- **Catholic Charities Dental Clinics**
Preventive, diagnostic, emergency and restorative oral health care to adults and children who are uninsured
