Programs and services addressing public health issues for low-income families in West Baltimore

Catholic Charities programs available to residents include:

- **Family and Kinship Navigator Services**
Resource and referral program for children with needs related to mental health or developmental disabilities
- **Family-to-Family Respite Program**
Overnight relief for caregivers who face the challenge of raising a child with emotional or behavioral problems
- **Home-Based Respite Program**
Professional staff provide therapeutic opportunities for children with mental health challenges, while also giving a break to the caregiver
- **In-Home Intervention Programs**
Intensive in-home intervention to empower families, divert children from hospitalization or residential treatment, and maintain children in their homes
- **Mental Health Assessment Team**
Mental health assessments for children entering the child welfare system in Baltimore City.
- **Villa Maria Behavioral Health Clinic**
Behavioral health services, including counseling, psychiatric evaluation, social and coping skill development, and medication management
