## HOUSING AND SERVICES FOR THE HOMELESS

Catholic Charities offers a range of programs:

- **Christopher Place Employment Academy**  
Intensive residential program providing education, training, and recovery support to formerly homeless men of the Baltimore area
- **Earn Benefits**  
Screening program for public benefits and financial assistance
- **Project Promise, Project Reach**  
Permanent individual housing for homeless people with disabilities
- **Project FRESH Start**  
Helps eligible homeless families find stable, affordable housing

**Father Joubert House** | 1003 Brentwood Ave.

Residential boarding and scholarship program for homeless/at risk young men from Baltimore City, providing year-round housing, meals, activities and a scholarship to St. Frances Academy

## COMMUNITY RESOURCES

**St. Vincent de Paul Society** provides a range of support for local residents suffering from the effects of poverty: child and family services, permanent supportive housing, workforce development, healthy meals for food-insecure children

- **Parish-based outreach in District 45**  
St. Anthony of Padua, Most Precious Blood, Shrine of the Little Flower, and St. Francis Xavier parish societies provide food, utility and rent assistance, and other support to help people through difficult times
- **Caroline Center** | 900 Somerset St.  
Job training center that prepares unemployed and underemployed women in Baltimore City to become healthcare professionals: certified nursing assistants and pharmacy technicians
- **Family Provider Partnership**  
Family-support group program
- **KidzTable** | 1901 62nd St.  
Provides fresh, nutritious meals to children in the Baltimore area
- **Next Course** | 1901 62nd St.  
Full-time food service training course that combines classroom instruction with hands-on experience in the KidzTable kitchen

### SHARE Food Network

A community-based organization open to all, offering groceries at a discount, through high-volume purchasing and volunteer support

**Parish-based volunteer ministries** provide a range of outreach services for the community and city, such as food collections/donations for inner city churches, prepare meals for Beans and Bread soup kitchen, and are active in programs such as Meals on Wheels.

## FAMILY, CHILD AND HEALTH SERVICES

**Head Start Caroline** | 1415 N. Caroline St.

Comprehensive pre-school education program designed to prepare low-income children for academic success operated by St. Vincent de Paul

Catholic Charities offers a range of programs for residents:

- **Baltimore Child and Adolescent Response System**  
Comprehensive community-based services for children in mental health crisis
- **Home-Based Respite Program**  
Professional staff provide therapeutic opportunities for children with mental health challenges, while also giving a break to the caregiver
- **In-Home Intervention Programs**  
Intensive in-home intervention to empower families, divert children from hospitalization or residential treatment, and maintain children in their homes
- **Mental Health Assessment Team**  
Mental health assessments for children entering the child welfare system in Baltimore City
- **Villa Maria Behavioral Health Clinic**  
Behavioral health services, including counseling, psychiatric evaluation, social and coping skill development, and medication management

**Chaplaincy services at all hospitals**, including Johns Hopkins Hospital
