## COMMUNITY RESOURCES

- **Answers for the Aging**  
Free information and referral service addressing questions about services for older adults, families, friends and caregivers
- **Family Provider Partnership**  
Engages families in sharing the power and responsibility for how services are provided; includes family support groups throughout central Maryland
- **Family-to-Family Respite Program**  
Overnight relief for caregivers who face the challenge of raising a child with emotional or behavioral problems
