SENIOR SERVICES | VICTORY HOUSING

189 rent-assisted independent and assisted-living apartments for seniors:

COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Parish-based programs serving the community in District 14 include these and many more services and programs:

- **Financial assistance** for rent and utility relief, prescription assistance and other needs
- **Food, meals and assistance:** parish food pantries, area shelters, and for local families in need
- **Parish nursing** and other health care ministry

Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Washington

offers a wide range of services for residents, including

- **Legal Network**
Pro bono legal services including issues with debt, employment, family law, landlord-tenant, public benefits, wills and probate, guardianship and conservatorship
- **Community Companions**
After-school programs, in-home support, respite breaks and camps in special needs families when caregivers need to work or rest
- **Community Options**
Day program for adults with severe cognitive or physical disabilities
- **Financial Stability Network**
Pro bono financial services, including financial coaching, education, and tax assistance for low income families to increase income, build and sustain assets
- **Immigration Legal Services**
Pro bono legal immigration services for foreign-born individuals and their families
- **Sanctuaries for Life**
Support program for women facing an unintended pregnancy, including prenatal care, labor/delivery, and connections for housing, food, clothing, and education.
- **SHARE Food Network**
Discount grocery program that is community-based and open to all, possible through high-volume purchasing and volunteer engagement

- **Spanish Catholic Center**
Holistic services to immigrants from around the world, including medical and dental care, job training, English classes, food pantry, and case management
- **Supported Employment Program**
Support for adults with developmental disabilities to enter the workforce
- **Strong Families Initiative**
Provides youth an outlet to discuss hardships they are facing, to be better equipped to face future difficulties
- **Welcome Home Reentry Program**
Volunteer mentoring to men and women returning to their communities after incarceration

Residence for women with intellectual disabilities to live independently, with the support and sponsorship of St. Peter's parish in Olney; developed through Rosaria Communities of the Archdiocese of Washington

Connects low-income and uninsured patients with specialized, pro bono health care services

Volunteer doctors, nurses and other health care professionals provide free primary health care to people in Montgomery County who do not have access to medical care through public benefits or private insurance.
