# Catholic Services and Programs in District 22 *(partial list)*

## COMMUNITY RESOURCES

The local parishes serve the community in a number of ways:

- **St. Jerome's Cafe** | 5205 43rd Ave., Hyattsville  
Free weekly hot meal for individuals in the community who are hungry and financially in need plus bagged lunches to go; meals are prepared and served by parishioners and students at the parish school
- **Parish food pantry**
- **Parish health ministry**  
St. Vincent de Paul Society, whose volunteers provide support for the poor and those in temporary need of assistance

Catholic Charities offers a range of programs available to residents in District 22, including:

- **Family Preservation Program** | 8200 Good Luck Rd., Lanham  
Works with families at risk of having their children removed from the home due to suspected abuse or neglect
- **Financial Stability Network**  
Pro bono financial services, including financial coaching, education, and tax assistance for low income families to increase income, build and sustain assets
- **Immigration Legal Services**  
Pro bono legal immigration services for foreign-born individuals and their families
- **In-Home Intervention Programs**  
Intensive in-home intervention to empower families, divert children from hospitalization or residential treatment, and maintain children in their homes
- **SHARE Food Network**  
Discount grocery program that is community-based and open to all, possible through high-volume purchasing and volunteer engagement
- **Legal Network**  
Pro bono legal services including issues with debt, employment, family law, landlord-tenant, public benefits, wills and probate, guardianship and conservatorship
- **Parish Partners Program** - Connects Catholic parishes seeking to assist local families with Catholic Charities' expertise and services; also provides training, networking and support for the development of parish social ministries, and an emergency service guide for the county

- **Supported Employment Program**  
8200 Good Luck Rd., Lanham  
Support for adults with developmental disabilities to enter the workforce
- **Welcome Home Reentry Program**  
8200 Good Luck Rd., Lanham  
Volunteer mentoring to men and women returning to their communities after incarceration

## HEALTH CARE AND RELATED SERVICES

Catholic Charities health care programs available to residents:

- **Catholic Charities Health Care Network**  
Connects low-income and uninsured patients with specialized, pro bono health care services
- **Catholic Charities Medical Clinic**  
Free primary and specialized health care from volunteer doctors, nurses, and other health care professionals for people in the county who do not have access to medical care through public benefits or private insurance
- **Catholic Charities Dental Clinic**  
Preventive, diagnostic, emergency and restorative oral health care for adults and children who are uninsured

**Sacred Heart Home** | 5805 Queens Chapel Rd., Hyattsville  
Long-term care residence for 100 infirm and elderly, most Medicaid-eligible; a ministry of the Sisters Servants of Mary Immaculate

**Chaplaincy services at all hospitals**, including Doctors Community Hospital
