## COMMUNITY RESOURCES

### **St. Vincent de Paul Society of St. Joseph, Largo**

Parish-based volunteer outreach offering person-to-person support to those in need, maintains a food pantry, distributes food baskets, serves at a local shelter and more

**Catholic Charities** offers a range of programs to residents, including:

- **Financial Stability Network**  
Pro bono financial services, including financial coaching, education, and tax assistance for low income families to increase income, build and sustain assets
- **Immigration Legal Services**  
Pro bono legal immigration services for foreign-born individuals and their families
- **SHARE Food Network** | 3222 Hubbard Rd., Landover  
Discount grocery program that is community-based and open to all, possible through high-volume purchasing and volunteer engagement
- **Legal Network**  
Pro bono legal services including issues with debt, employment, family law, landlord-tenant, public benefits, wills and probate, guardianship and conservatorship
- **Parish Partners Program** - Connects Catholic parishes seeking to assist local families with Catholic Charities' expertise and services; also provides training, networking and support for the development of parish social ministries, and an emergency service guide for the county
- **Supported Employment Program**  
Support for adults with developmental disabilities to enter the workforce
- **Welcome Home Reentry Program**  
Volunteer mentoring to men and women returning to their communities after incarceration

### **Holy Cross Dialysis Center at Woodmore**

Provides dialytic therapy to patients with acute renal failure or end-stage renal disease

**Catholic Charities** health care programs available to residents:

- **Catholic Charities Health Care Network and Medical Clinics**  
Free primary and specialized health care from volunteer doctors, nurses, and other health care professionals for people in the county who do not have access to medical care through public benefits or private insurance
- **Catholic Charities Dental Clinic**  
Preventive, diagnostic, emergency and restorative oral health care for adults and children who are uninsured
- **In-Home Intervention Programs**  
Intensive in-home intervention to empower families, divert children from hospitalization or residential treatment, and maintain children in their homes
