Anna's House

Transitional housing and emergency shelter for homeless women and children in Harford County offering case management, counseling, career and life skills training, and employment assistance

Work4Success

Intensive two-week employment preparation program for clients at Anna's House

COMMUNITY RESOURCES CATHOLIC CHARITIES

Basic Needs Program

Support low-income households through financial crises with case management, financial literacy, budget counseling, job readiness, rent/mortgage/utility assistance, clothing, household goods, furniture, diapers, food, and referrals

Family Provider Partnership

Family-support group program

Family-to-Family Respite Program

Overnight relief for caregivers who face the challenge of raising a child with emotional or behavioral problems

Home-Based Respite Program

Professional staff provide therapeutic opportunities for children with mental health challenges, while also giving a break to the caregiver

Immigration Counseling

Comprehensive immigration counseling to assist individuals and families in immigration and naturalization processes

In-Home Intervention Programs

Intensive in-home intervention to empower families, divert children from hospitalization or residential treatment, and maintain children in their homes

Safe Start

Help prevent child abuse and neglect by providing services such as behavioral management techniques, stress management, problem-solving, budgeting, communication and organization skills

Pregnancy Counseling

Medical referrals, and pregnancy and parenting counseling to support expectant parents

Routine Outpatient Counseling

Outpatient counseling for individuals with emotional, behavioral, and mental health concerns

Behavioral health services, including counseling, psychiatric evaluation, social and coping skill development, and medication management
