# WHO DO WE HELP?

## Low Income Energy Consumers

- Coloradans statewide
- Residential homes in critical need of energy related home improvements
- Seniors, veterans, teachers, neighbors, members of your community
- In 2017, EOC provided 16,038 homes with energy bill payment assistance
  - \$6.62 million statewide

# PROGRAMS

## What We Do

- Energy bill payment assistance, weatherization, residential and multi-family home energy efficiency enhancements, non-profit facility energy-saving upgrades, energy efficiency education
- Leverage resources
- Partner with agencies and organizations to make dollars go farther
- Relationship with Utilities
- Advocacy

# FILLING THE GAP

## Where traditional funding stops – we step in

- CIP
  - 2016-17 FY = 1,590 households
  - Since October, assisted 1,320 households statewide
- CARE
  - 370 households served in 43 counties with 14 partner agencies
  - Unlocked over \$600K in utility funding
- Homeless to Home
  - Helping people return to housing

# HOMELESS TO HOME

- Helps reduce homelessness by paying debts on utility accounts that present barriers to entering/remaining in housing
- Increases clients ability to enter into and remain in stable housing long term and stay current with bills
- Pays maximum of \$3,000 per household
- Eligibility:
  - Entering into housing from homeless
  - Receiving services through a housing/homeless prevention program
  - At imminent risk of eviction with no prior history of homelessness

# ADVOCACY

## Part of the choir

- A voice in a chorus of low-income advocates
- Work with utilities statewide
  - Affordable bill
  - Fair and reasonable to begin with
  - Low-income voices are represented
- Help support your cause

# CENTRAL 70 PROJECT

## Partnerships matter

- Elyria Swansea partnership with CDOT and City of Denver
- Proactively mitigate impact on homes new I-70 construction area
- Secure homes from unhealthy construction dust, debris and noise.
  - Insulation, windows, doors,
- 282 homes – York to Colorado Blvd
- 87% participating in project
- Over 80% of the work has been completed
