OneHome Goals 2018

- Develop clear & simple process and communication
- Approach from an anti-oppressive and equity lens

- Ian Fletcher moving to lead HMIS Transition, new OneHome Program Manager hired: Bethany Maynard-Moody
- ESG & Denver's Road Home Contracts incorporated
- Graduation from PSH planning in process
- Built for Zero June 26-28
- RGC Vacancies for Adams County, JeffCo/Douglas Lived Experience
- Colorado House Bill HB18-1432 signed into law 6/6/2018
 - Prohibits housing discrimination based on source of income. Win!

Individuals Update



Total number of individual households leased-up in Jan- May 2018:

PSH: 72 RRH: 14

Currently there are 63 people matched to a housing resource and 90 people on prematch, 153 total listed as Active or Matched

21 people added to prematch this year were found to have resolved their homelessness outside of the OneHome system I.e subsidized housing, boarding houses, assisted living/SNF, family reunification

- Sent an email to case managers, outreach workers and agency liaisons of individuals on prematch with expired ROIs not in salesforce, and a follow up email earlier this week
- Overall, housing resources have slowed down

Family Update



Housed: 28 families have been housed through the OneHome System in 2018: 10 PSH & 18 RRH

Referrals:

- 5 families referred to 1st Step Warren Village
- 5 families in process with VOA RRH+C & RAD
- 8 families in process with RRH programs
- 28 families referred to Salvation Army ESG
 - 2 housed, 7 self-resolved and 19 in process

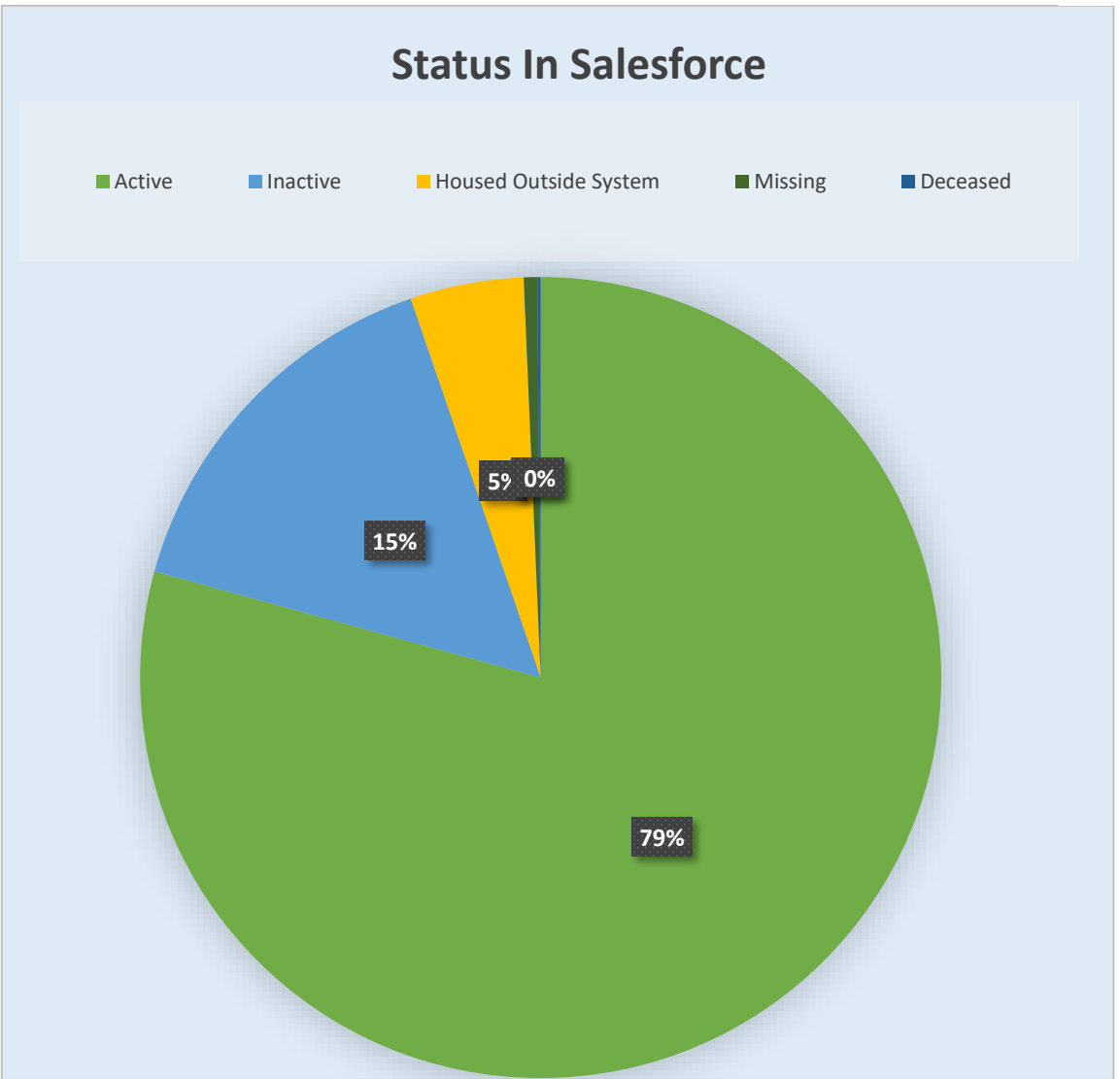
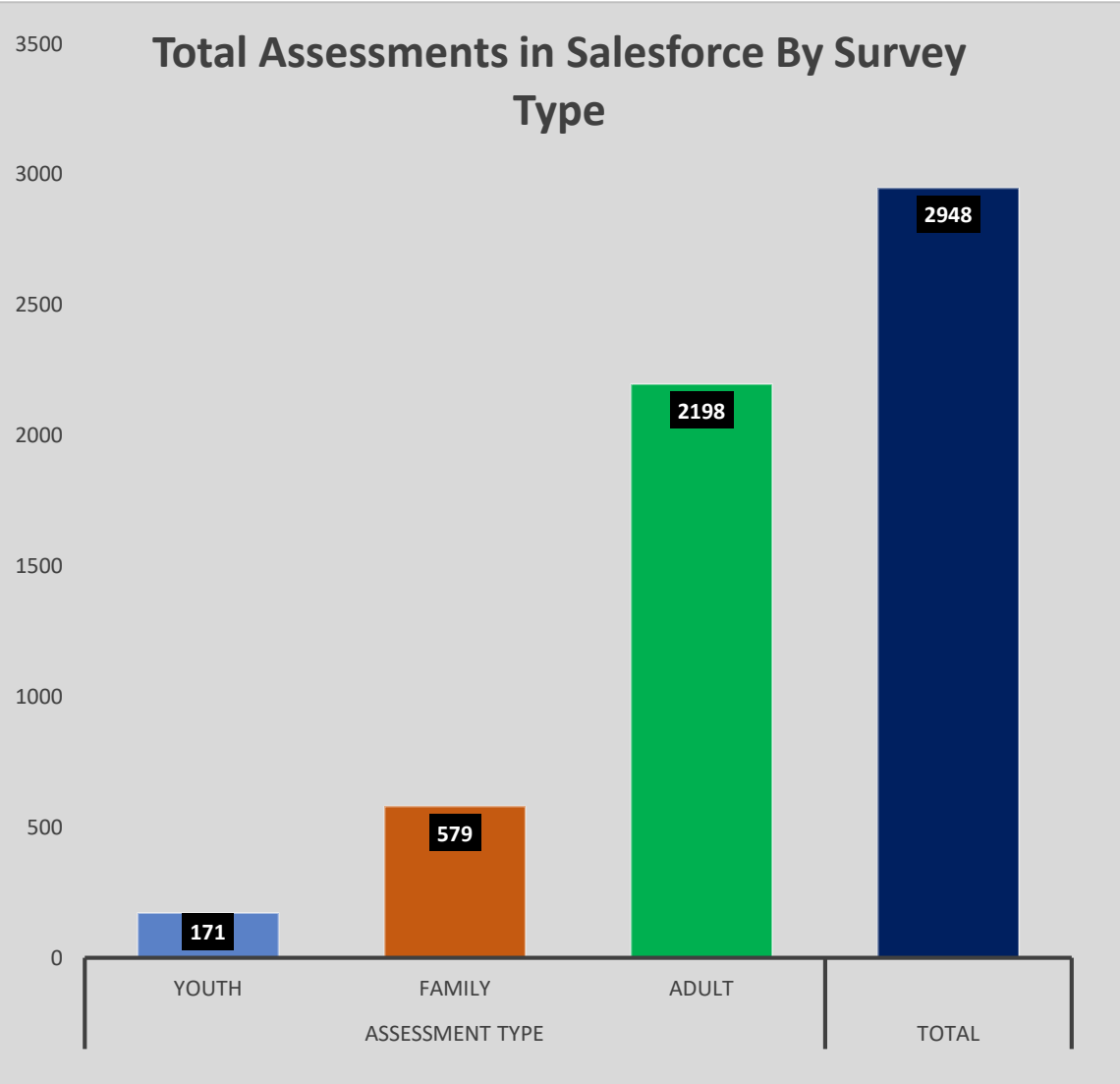
