Specific efforts for 2018:

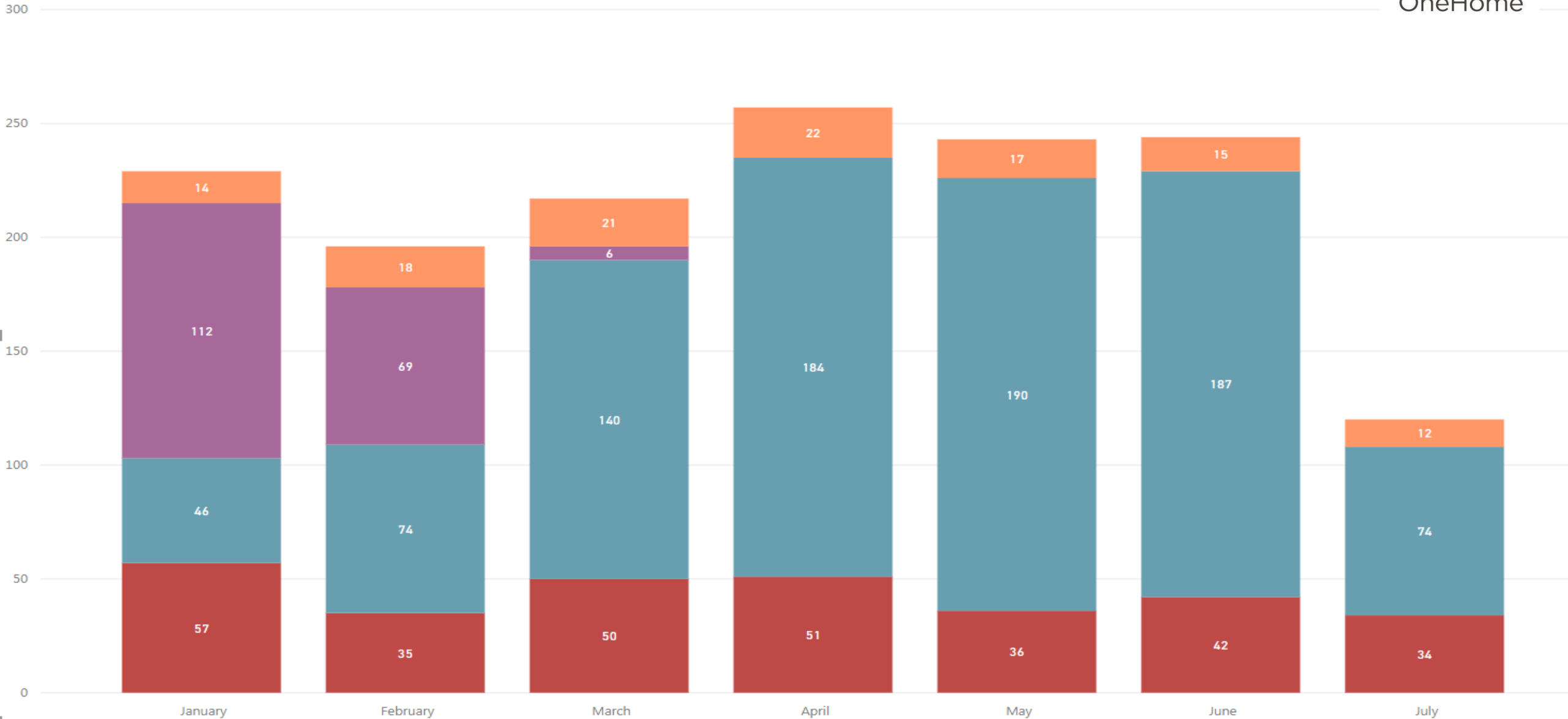
- Create consistent, regional access with a phased assessment approach

- Develop clear & simple process and communication
- Approach from an anti-oppressive and equity lens

Individuals Update



Total number of individual households leased-up in Jan- June 2018:

PSH: 83 RRH: 19

Currently there are 56 people matched to a housing resource and 92 people on prematch, 139 total listed as Active or Matched

22 people added to prematch this year were found to have resolved their homelessness outside of the OneHome system i.e subsidized housing, boarding houses, assisted living/SNF, family reunification, SIB project based housing

VOA's Irving St Women's Residence- Safe Haven shelter for chronically homeless women with mental illness receives referrals through OneHome from prematch- either matched to housing or not

Overall, housing resources have slowed down. Only one vacancy in Denver and a few in Boulder

Family Update



Housed: 28 families have been housed through the OneHome in
Jan-June 2018: 10 PSH & 18 RRH

Referrals:

- 6 families referred to 1st Step Warren Village
- 10 families referred to DHS RRH programs
- 1 family referred to Family Tree YTP
- 50 families referred to Salvation Army ESG
- 14 families currently in process with CCH RRH programs
