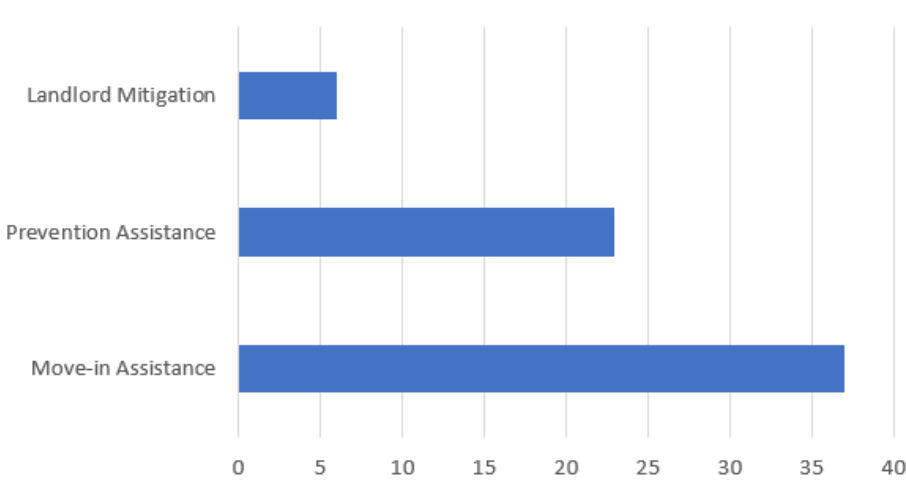

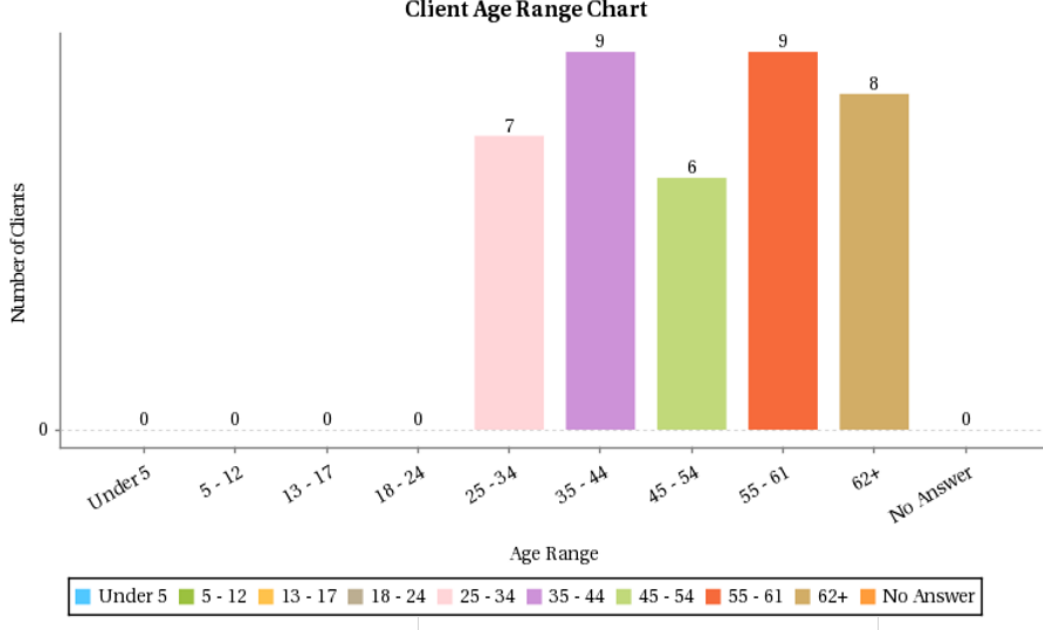
Total Types of Assistance Provided



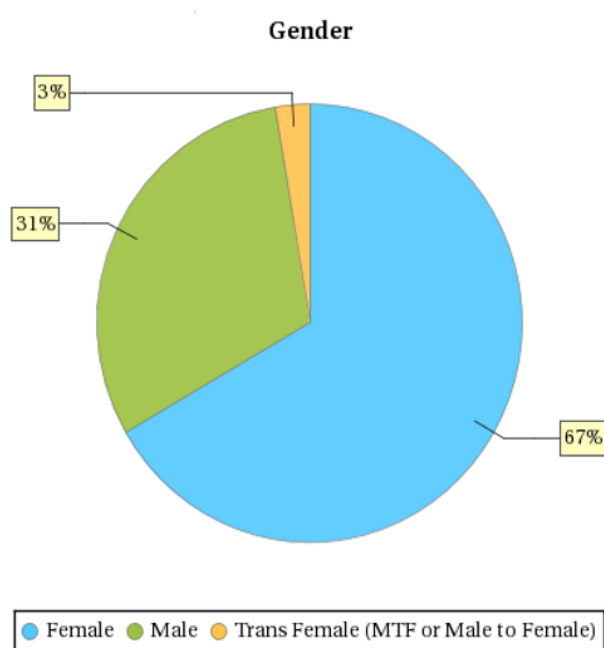
HMIS Client Demographics

Out of the 66 total households served April-June 2020, 39 were found and entered into HMIS

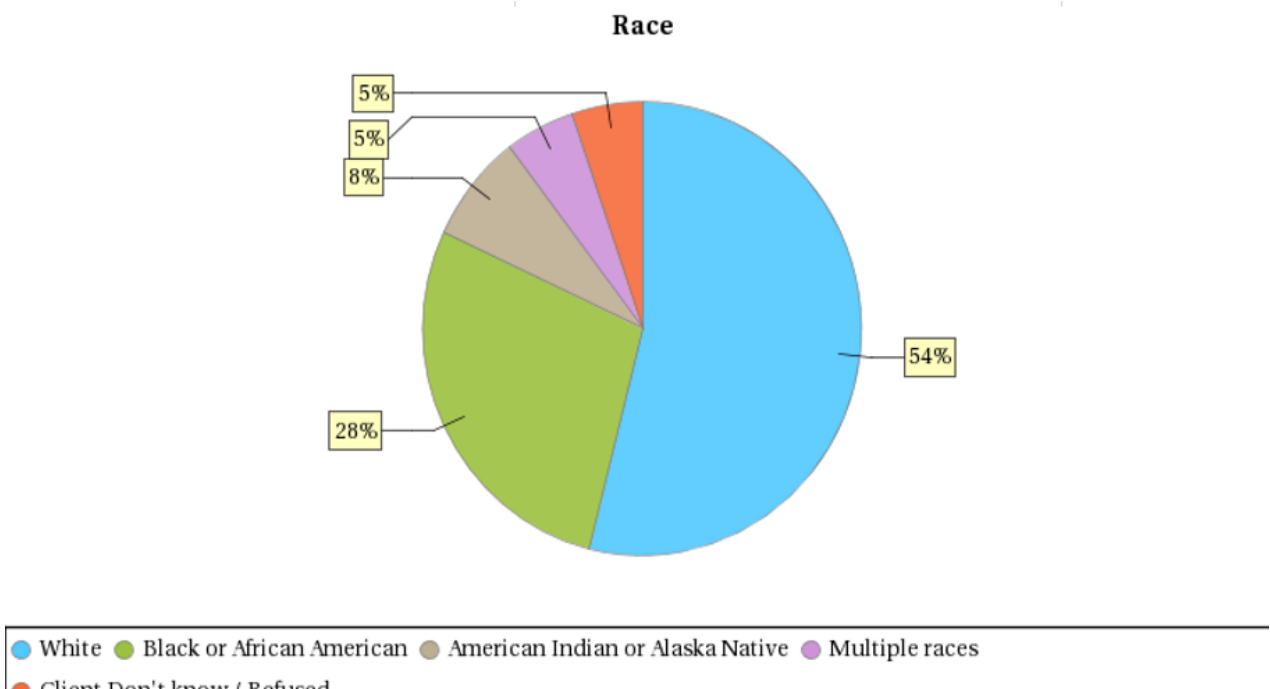
Age



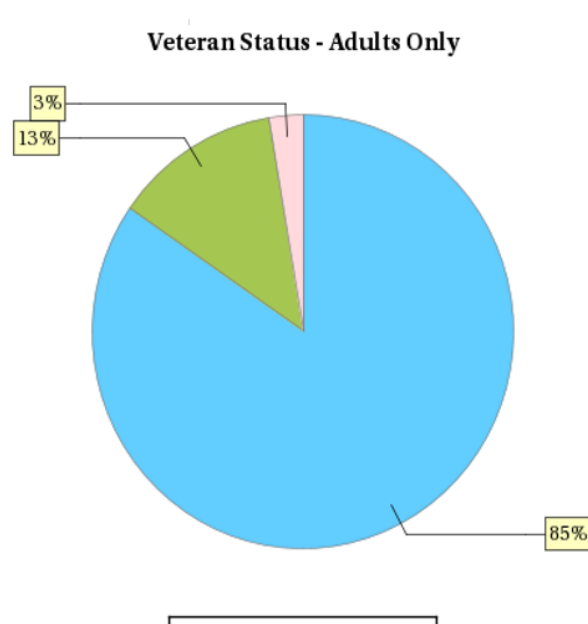
Gender
