In 2020, Flex Fund witnessed an increase in requests to assist households in achieving housing stability. In Spring 2020, Flex Fund began providing prevention assistance in response to COVID-19. On April 1st, 2020, Flex Fund started to utilize HMIS to efficiently gather program data and household information. Each year Flex Fund continues to expand services due to the growing need for housing assistance within the Metro Denver region.

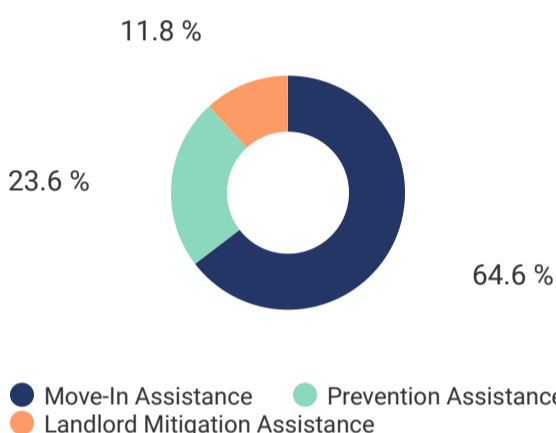

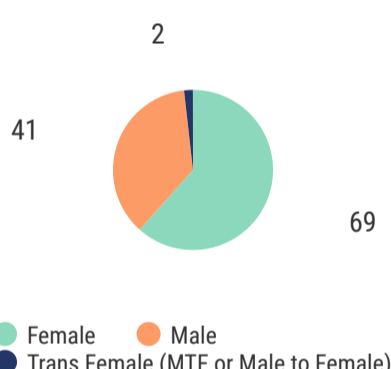

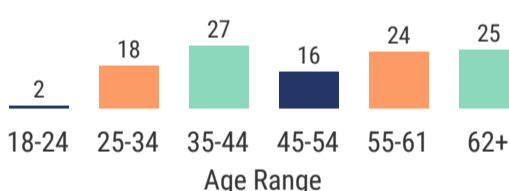
HMIS Demographics

Gender - Head of Household

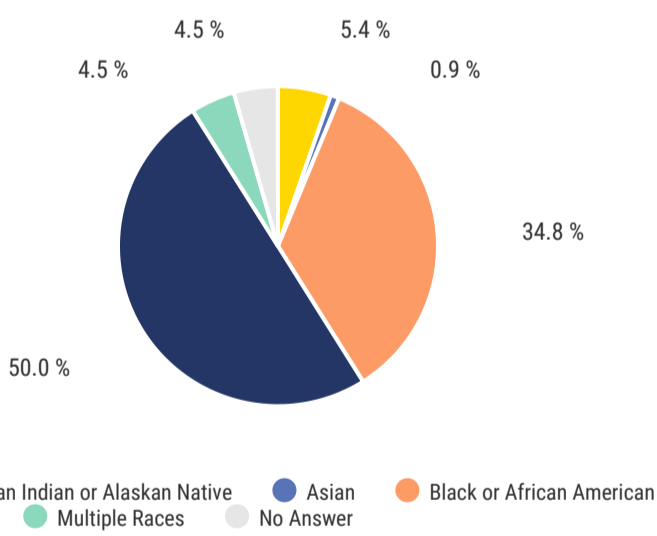


Age Range - Head of Household

Race - Head of Household



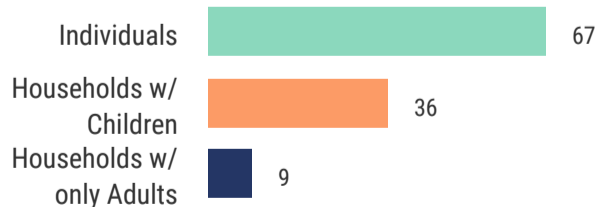

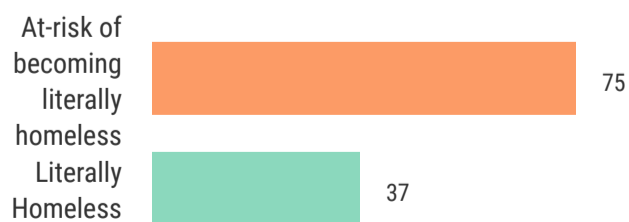
