Eligibility Criteria for Clients	Douglas County resident Guests 15+ must be able to pass a warrant/sex offender check Due to the logistics of our program, we are unable to serve individuals who are in an active domestic violence situation, are dealing with substance abuse issues, or who have an untreated mental health condition. We are unable to serve adult males.

<p>Process for Accessing Shelter (where to call, where and when to show-up, etc.)</p>	<p>Number and hours are listed above. Potential guests are referred to WSN by local social services agencies or through our website. New guests are admitted up to 2 pm for shelter that night. Once admitted to the program, guests are welcomed at our Overnight Host Church from 5 pm to 7 am. Overnight Host Churches host our guests for one night each week. Dinner, breakfast, and a sack lunch are provided each day. Ongoing case management is provided to our guests by our Care Coordinator.</p>
<p>Length of Stay Allowed</p>	<p>Unlimited if in compliance with guest guidelines and dependent on availability. Priority is given to guests engaged in the case management process.</p>
<p>Other info? (e.g. pets allowed, ID required, etc.)</p>	<p>Due to the logistics of our program, we are unable to serve individuals who are in an active domestic violence situation, are dealing with substance abuse issues, or who have an untreated mental health condition. We are unable to serve adult males. ID required upon admission and for entry. Service animals and emotional support animals are allowed with proof of a current rabies vaccination and appropriate accompanying documentation.</p>
