After Hours Contact Information (please specify hours of service)	The HOPE Emergency Warming Center is open from 6p.m. to 7a.m. the following morning.
Population Served (e.g. single women, families with children, couples, only residents of a certain city or county, etc.)	Single individuals from Longmont, CO. Men and women are separated.
Protocol for Activating (e.g. must be below 32 degrees, open every day from Oct-March or open intermittently)	Sheltering every night from Nov. 15- Mar. 15 or when the low is 25 degrees or less.
Eligibility Criteria for Clients	Lottery enrollment at 720-605-4673
Other Services Offered (e.g. meals, showers, transportation)	Meals, showers, case management, medical clinic
Process for Accessing Shelter (when to call, where and when to show-up, etc.)	Lottery recipients for sheltering will be notified by phone or text and can check the HOPE website for their User I.D. Arrive at 6p.m.
Length of Stay Allowed	One night at a time. Enter lottery for each night.
