Protocol for Activating (e.g. must be below 32 degrees, open every day from Oct-March or open intermittently)	October 1 - April 30 Overnight temps of 32 degrees or colder with wet conditions, or 20 degrees or colder with dry conditions
Eligibility Criteria for Clients	All potential guests must register via one of our partner agencies. Registration includes an annual background check.
Other Services Offered (e.g. meals, showers, transportation)	Host Site shelters provide a hot meal, a bed roll and transportation to and from the Host Site.
Process for Accessing Shelter (where to call, where and when to show-up, etc.)	Guests are given phone numbers and pick up locations after they have registered for the Network.
Length of Stay Allowed	No term limits. A person can stay as many nights in a season as is needed.
