The State Committee shall be composed of the elected state committeemen and state committeewomen from each county; the elected Democratic National Committee members from Florida; all state and federal elected officials; up to 4 Democratic city mayors appointed by the State Chair; 20 At-Large members to satisfy diversity issues, nominated by the State Chair and approved by the State Committee; an elected representative from each chartered State Democratic Caucus; and the representative of nationally recognized Democratic allied organizations as approved by the Committee on Clubs, Organizations and Caucuses (COCC) certification process. The state committeemen and state committeewomen from each county shall be elected at Democratic County Committee organizational meetings from among the registered Democrats in their county as set forth in the county's Bylaws. The term of office shall be four (4) years.

Each county shall be entitled to a minimum of one state committee member. One (1) additional state committee member will be allotted to counties for every 10,000 registered Democrats above the initial 9,999. State committee members shall be of different genders where possible and may include the Democratic County Chair. Each additional allocated state committee member shall be of a different gender than the previously allocated state committee member. Allocation numbers will be revisited every year on January 1.
