MINUTES

- -Chair Senator Dwight Bullard called meeting to order at 7:05 P.M. He welcomed all members and asked officials to continue registration. Meeting would start when all in line were checked in.
- -Seth Sklarey led the Pledge of Allegiance, Deltravis Williams led the invocation.
- -Chair Sen. Dwight Bullard emphasized the importance of this re-organizational meeting to energize the party and to be as committed as we are in this meeting in between election seasons.
- -Christine Florez spoke on behalf of the Elections Committee. She explained that we would be following the order of elections stated on the agenda and reviewed policies for nominating from the floor, speech time limits, and election process.
- -Former Congressional candidate Pam Keith addressed members regarding upcoming race in Louisiana. Efforts are being made at the ground level in Florida to travel to Louisiana this week to canvas for Foster Campbell in New Orleans and Baton Rouge. Donations are being accepted throughout the meeting.
- -Chair Sen. Dwight Bullard recommended we table credentials report to go onto swearing in after registration is completed.
- -Barbara Schwartz announced initiative for anyone to wear a black ribbon on inauguration day because we will be in mourning. She Encouraged members to take a piece, then spread the word to all organizations and make initiative go viral.
- -Tere Gavalda announced there was a quorum with 139 voting members signed-in.
- -Chair Sen. Dwight Bullard initiated the swearing-in process. All voting members stood up and repeated the loyalty oath. Chair announced voting will commence and ballots would be collected in an orderly fashion. People will be called up row by row.
- -Chair Sen. Dwight Bullard opened the floor for nominations for chair.
- -Lorenzo Canizares, Pct. 766 nominated Dr. Leonarda Duran for chair. Duysevi Miyar. Pct. 303 seconded. Dr. Leonarda Duran accepted and gave her speech.
- -Donald Abicht, Pct. 713 nominated Fred Frost for chair. Glenda Abicht, Pct. 713 seconded. Fred Frost accepted nomination and gave speech.
- -Chair Sen. Dwight Bullard announced the removal of Dr. Mae Christian's name from the Chair's race. She will no longer be running for Chair.
- -Richard Lamondin, Pct. 518 nominated Juan Cuba for chair. Edith Owens, Pct. 221 seconded. Juan Cuba accepted the nomination and gave speech.
- -Annie Betancourt, Pct. 609 nominated Millie Herrera for chair. Deltravis Williams, Pct. 817 seconded. Millie Herrera accepted the nomination and gave speech.



- -Dan Di Matteo, Pct. 029 nominated Rafael Velazquez for chair. Olivia Cutting, Pct. 845 seconded the nomination. Rafael Velazquez accepted the nomination and gave speech.
- -Isabel Loaiza, Pct. 23 nominated Ernesto Fernandez for chair. Victor Nieto, Pct. 148 seconded. Ernesto Fernandez withdrew his nomination.
- -Motion to close the nominations for Chair was made and seconded. Voting ensued.
- -Outgoing Chair Sen. Dwight Bullard announced Juan Cuba as new Chair of the party with 99 of the votes. No runoff necessary. Dr. Duran won 26 votes, Millie Herrera won 22 votes, Fred Frost won 21 votes, and Rafael Velazquez won 21 votes.
- -Chair Juan Cuba accepted his position and began by opening nominations for Sate Committeewoman.
- -Dr. Leonarda Duran, Pct. 969 nominated Francesca Menes for State Committeewoman. Chris Riker Pct. 143 seconded. Francesca Menes accepted the nomination and gave speech.
- -Rafael Velazquez, Pct. 048 nominated Dr. Mae Christian for State Committeewoman. America Schroh seconded. Dr. Mae Christian accepted the nomination and gave speech.
- -Bernard Jennings, Pct. 239 nominated Elizabeth Judd for State Committeewoman. Edith Owens, Pct. 221 seconded. Elizabeth Judd accepted nomination and gave speech.

- -Deltravis Williams, pct. 817 nominated Dwight Bullard for State Committeeman. Senator Oscar Braynon seconded. Dwight Bullard accepted the nomination and gave speech.
- -Motion to close the nomination for State Committeeman was made and seconded. Voting ensued.
- -Chair Juan Cuba announced Francesca Menes as State committeewoman with 107 of the votes. No runoff necessary. Elizabeth Judd won 32 votes, Dr. Mae Christian won 11 votes, Bess McElroy won 10 votes, Elizabeth Rodriguez won 8 votes, and Elizabeth Washington Wells won 3 votes.
- -Chair Juan Cuba opened the floor open for nominations for female First Vice Chair.
- -Deltravis Williams, Pct. 817 nominated Anette Taddeo for Vice Chair. Donald Abicht, Pct. 713 seconded. Annette Taddeo accepted the nomination and gave speech.
- -Bob Goldstein nominated Dotie Joseph for Vice Chair. Tracy Weems, Pct. 971 seconded. Dotie Joseph accepted the nomination and gave speech.



- -Verlance Echoles, Pct. 262 nominated Dr. Mae Christian for Vice Chair. Eddie Lewis, Pct. 155 seconded. Dr. Mae Christian accepted the nomination and gave speech.
- -Motion to close the nomination for Vice Chair was made and seconded. Voting ensued.
- -Chair Juan Cuba announced Bret Berlin as State Committeeman with 106 of the votes. No runoff necessary. Dwight Bullard won 47 votes and Manuel Gutierrez won 9 votes.
- -Chair Juan Cuba opened the floor open for nominations for Secretary.

- -Chair Juan Cuba announced Arthur Costa as Treasurer with 99 votes. No runoff necessary. Carlos Condarco won 43 votes and Gonzalo Vizcardo won 13 votes.
