Dear Prosecutor Smith,

Pursuant to Section 944 of Michigan of the Michigan Election Code, Michigan Compiled Laws 168.944 provides that a person who performs the following act is guilty of a misdemeanor:

“168.944 False designation of incumbency; misdemeanor.

Sec. 944.

Any person who advertises or uses in any campaign material, including radio, television, newspapers, circulars, cards, or stationery, the words incumbent, re-elect, re-election, or otherwise indicates, represents, or gives the impression that a candidate for public office is the incumbent, when in fact the candidate is not the incumbent, is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable as provided in section 934.”

Based on the attached document, it is clear that Michael R. Notte is showing an incumbency designation in his campaign for State Representative. As you will notice, the sign that Mr. Notte is holding suggests that Mr. Notte is the “State Representative.” Mr. Notte’s address is as follows:

No one is above the law, not even Michael Notte. Michael Notte’s blatant violation of the criminal provisions of the Michigan Election Code must be punished. Accordingly, I respectfully ask that you perform your duty to issue a complaint against Michael Notte.
