Communications Internship

The core mission of this internship is to help us tell the story of our supporters and how we carry out our mission. This includes:

- **Content creation:** interview and take/gather photos of Michigan IPL supporters, especially members of congregations who are engaged in Earth care projects or advocacy.
- **Content dissemination:** assist in updating our website, creating marketing materials, drafting newsletters, and correspondence.

Desirable Skills and Qualities:

- Genuine interest in talking with and learning from others
- Ability to find and tell stories
- Solid verbal and written communication skills
- Technologically savvy and comfortable with photography and/or video
- Experience/talent with basic graphic design (We use Microsoft Publisher and can provide you with Office software, if needed.)
- Ability to work independently
- Curiosity and good humor are required

Other Details:

The intern will receive a modest \$500 stipend at the completion of the internship. We are also totally willing to work with you to get academic credit or set up a work-study arrangement if offered by your school. While we are an interfaith organization, you do not need to ascribe to any religious ideology to work with us. Our office is located in metro Detroit, and it is possible for the intern to work remotely with only occasional time spent in the office. Since the ideal candidate will need to conduct in-person interviews and take on site photographs, access to a car is necessary (we will reimburse mileage). We prefer a 3-month commitment (at any time of the year) for approximately 20-25 hours per week. Start and end dates are flexible.
