



## Economic Accomplishments of the Trump Administration

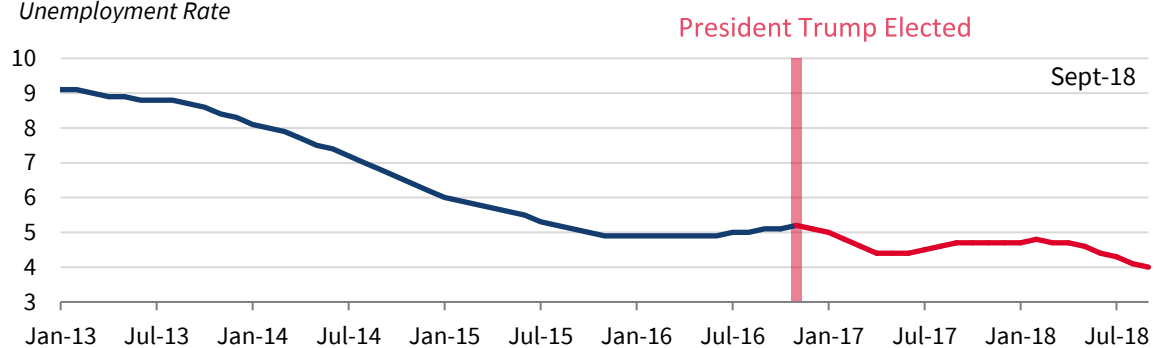
### Michigan

Michigan has demonstrated strong economic growth during the past year, with steady income and wage gains and impressive growth in mining, logging, and construction employment.

- The Tax Cuts and Jobs Act signed into law by President Trump last year is estimated to lead to a 7.1 percent increase in wage and salary income for Michigan's average household.
- The unemployment rate in Michigan has fallen 1.2 percentage points since the election of President Trump to 4.1 percent, the lowest rate since 2000.
- Monthly initial claims for unemployment insurance in Michigan have fallen by over 23 percent since President Trump was elected and recently fell to their lowest level in recorded history.
- Michigan's mining, logging, and construction industry has led employment growth since the President was elected, increasing by over 10 percent.
- Total manufacturing employment in Michigan has increased by over 2.4 percent since President Trump was elected rising to 624,200 total employees.
- Utility rates have been reduced for at least 3.6 million Michigan customers as a direct result of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act signed into law by President Trump last year.
- Real Gross State Product (a similar measure to GDP at a state level) in Michigan has increased by 2.1 percent since President Trump took office to \$446.4 billion.
