ALDERMAN SANTIAGO HOSTS CTA HIRING APPLICATION WORKSHOP

CHICAGO – Tomorrow, April 28, 2018, 31st Ward Alderman Milly Santiago will join the Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) in hosting a job position application workshop for Ward residents. Applicants are encouraged to attend to find out more information regarding open CTA career positions that include bus operator opportunities. Ward and CTA personnel will be present to assist applicants in the online portion of the application process. Their application will also be evaluated by CTA personnel, which will provide an opportunity to get a possibility of securing an interview for the jobs available.

“I would like to encourage residents of the 31st Ward to attend this event, which will provide an opportunity to apply for well-paying jobs with the CTA and perhaps get a chance to start a long, new career path,” said Alderman Santiago. “I am excited to be a partner in this effort because I understand the need for well-paying jobs in my community.”

Applicants should be at least 21 years old, have a high school diploma or GED preferred, and hold a valid State of Illinois driver’s license along with a safe driving record. Applicants should also submit to and pass drug and alcohol testing as mandated by the Federal Transit Administration. Applicants are also encouraged to come prepared with proper identification, resume (if available), and other documentation.

The first workshop will begin at 9AM, the second will begin at 11AM, at Foreman College & Career Academy, located at 3235 N. Leclaire Ave. The event will run until 2PM. Alderman Santiago will be available for interviews.
