The New CityKey Also Offers a Series of Benefits in Savings

CHICAGO – Today, May 19, 2018, Alderman Santiago will be hosting the Community Ward Sale event. The 31st Ward Office will be offering residents the opportunity to purchase vehicle stickers, dog licenses, and the brand new CityKey municipal ID, provided by The Office of the City Clerk. **Only the first 75 people will receive the CityKey ID.**

“The CityKey Municipal ID program has been an important tool for residents, especially for the immigrant residents, in getting a form of ID that will provide them with access to the basic services and needs,” said Alderman Santiago. “I want to commend Mayor Emanuel, the rest of the City Council members, and The Office of the City Clerk for their endorsement of this idea knowing the thousands of residents across the City that will benefit from this program.”

Alderman Santiago will be having representatives from The Office of the City Clerk’s Office assisting residents in obtaining their CityKey and answering any questions regarding the exciting new benefits of this ID. This is the first time that the City of Chicago has recognized the need to issue its own “City” identification in an effort to provide an additional form of official document as residents of our City.

The event will be taking place tomorrow, Saturday, May 19th from 10am until 2pm, at our Ward Office – 2521 N. Pulaski Rd.
