## A RESOLUTION TO PURSUE A CLEAN, AFFORDABLE, RELIABLE, AND LOCAL ENERGY FUTURE BY GIVING THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS SUSTAINABLE ENERGY OPTIONS

Whereas, Minneapolis is dependent mostly on imported and inefficiently used coal, nuclear, and gas; and

Whereas, our energy options are decided by energy monopolies Xcel Energy (electric) and Centerpoint Energy (gas) whose first priority is their shareholders, not the public;

Whereas, the City of Minneapolis will have the once-in-a-generation opportunity to negotiate agreements with Xcel Energy and Centerpoint Energy regarding their service in Minneapolis in 2014;

Whereas, Minneapolis residents want to make energy more affordable through reduced energy use and increased efficiency; and

Whereas, Minneapolis residents want our energy dollars to pay for clean, local energy instead importing polluting energy; and

Whereas, increasing clean, local energy and reducing energy use can significantly increase local jobs and economic activity in an equitable manner; and

Whereas, other US cities have taken action to increase their energy options; and

Whereas, the City has nothing to lose by creating energy options.
