

Person specification for people to be considered by Momentum for the left slate for the South East Regional Board.

Criteria

- 1. Demonstrable commitment to the democratisation of the Labour Party and its transformation into a socialist, members-led party capable of harnessing the energy and talents of all its members and winning elections.
- 2. Experience of representing members and defending and advancing their concerns within Labour movement structures.
- 3. Intermediate understanding of Labour Party structures, including the Rule Book, and of the South East Regional Standing orders.
- 4. Demonstrable commitment to working and organising collectively, including by prioritising the objectives of the Labour left.
- 5. Experience of developing positive and robust working relationships with diverse Labour movement stakeholders, including trade unionists, party staffers, and other elected representatives.
- 6. Ability to analyse the regional political landscape and make strategic assessments about which issues to prioritise.
- 7. Strong interpersonal skills, including the ability to win people over with persuasion, manage conflict and build positive and robust working relationships with people at all levels of the Labour movement.
- 8. Ability to exercise a high level of discretion, diplomacy, and judgment in sensitive political situations.
- 9. Integrity and sensitivity to ethical and equalities issues and a strong commitment to equal opportunity in all matters.
- 10. Ability and willingness to read papers in advance, and raise relevant issues with other supportive representatives in advance of meetings.

- 11. Ability and willingness to attend all regional Conference meetings, relevant subcommittee meetings, and panels.
- 12. Ability and willingness to report back accurately to party members, and take up their concerns and cases with the regional board.
